

SOUTH AFRICAN FOOTBALL TOUR ITINERARY JUNE/ JULY 2010

THURSDAY 24 JUNE AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL CITY

Depart Australian Capital Cities for your flight to South Africa.

FRIDAY 25 JUNE AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL CITY/ SOUTH AFRICA

Upon arrival into Johannesburg you will be met by your tour representatives and transferred to your accommodation at the Konka Camp where you will stay for the next 9 nights on a half board basis (breakfast and dinner included).

After checking in you will have the first team meeting before settling down to watch a 2010 FIFA World Cup South Africa™ final group game on the big screen. There are 4 World Cup games today live on television from the various parts of South Africa.

SATURDAY 26 JUNE KONKA CAMP

This morning you will play your first fixture against a local team.

After lunch you will transfer to the Lion Park where you will have the opportunity to come face to face with the big cats.

There are four World Cup games broadcast on television today from various parts of South Africa.



SUNDAY 27 JUNE KONKA CAMP

This morning there will be some scheduled coaching. The rest of the day will be free for optional game walk or activities at the camp.

Later on in the day you will be transferred to Soccer City Stadium to watch your first 2010 FIFA World Cup South Africa™ match. This will be the knock out game between the winner of group B and the runner up of group A

MONDAY 28 JUNE KONKA CAMP



Today you will transfer to Gold Reef City for a full day excursion to experience what Old Johannesburg was like during the gold mining days.

After an interesting and informative tour you will transfer to the magnificent Ellis Park Stadium for your second 2010 FIFA World Cup South Africa™ match which will be between the winner of group G and the runner up of group H.

TUESDAY 29 JUNE SOWETO

This morning the group will visit the township of Soweto which is the former home of Nelson Mandela, Bishop Desmond Tutu and heartland of the Apartheid Movement.

Following lunch you will play your second game of the tour Vs local a local school or club.

During the evening you will make the short trip to Loftus Versfeld Stadium to attend your third 2010 FIFA World Cup South Africa™ game between the winner of group F and the runner up of group E.

WEDNESDAY 30 JUNE KONKA CAMP

Rise early to head to the Pilansberg Game Reserve at first light in search of the “Big Five”. Anticipation builds on the scenic drive to the reserve and once on the Veldt the excitement will be awe inspiring as the search begins for the magnificent Lion, shy and elusive Leopard, the family oriented Elephant, bad tempered Rhino and Buffalo.



Following the game reserve you will transfer to Sun City for a day of entertainment at the Valley of the Waves.

Return to your accommodation in the late afternoon.



THURSDAY 01 JULY KONKA CAMP

During the afternoon you will play your third game of the tour against a local school or club. Following the game there will be an after match function.

FRIDAY 02 JULY KONKA CAMP

Please note interim payments after the initial \$1,000.00 are transferable to another person provided the group numbers remain the same.

Cancellation charges per tour member: (Notice of cancellation must be made in writing)

Time of booking to 1st February 2010: \$500.00

2nd of February 2010 – 31st of March 2010: \$1,500.00

1st of April 2010 - departure date : 50% of total tour cost

After departure – 100% cancellation fee – NIL REFUND

Please note there may be specialised inclusions in your tour such as Train Tickets, Theatre Show tickets, instant purchase airline tickets etc that are non-refundable in addition to the above Cancellation Charges. These cancellation fees are in addition to any cancellation fees that may be levied by our tour suppliers.

Amendment Fee : Any person wishing to amend from the group tour arrangements (outside the tour package) will be charged a standard \$100.00 amendment fee per person plus any additional charges involved with the amendment (increase in airfare, additional transfers, accommodation etc). Please note no alternations or deviations will be accepted during the tour package.

Accommodation : Bedding arrangements are likely to be multi-bedded rooms and could include bunk beds. Bathroom facilities will be shared.

Match tickets : World Cup match tickets are secured through Premium Sports Tours, an Official Match (FIFA) Participating Tour Operator. Gullivers Sport Travel is the officially appointed and sole agent for the tour.

Documentation: Australian citizens require a passport with minimum 6 months validity from date of departure from final destination. Other passport holders may require additional documentation. Please check your applicable requirements with our Travel Consultant. A copy of each person's passport is required.

Baggage: Free baggage allowance one piece weighing maximum 20 kg plus 1 cabin bag (piece) of 115cm with a maximum weight of 5kg per person (please note these restrictions vary between airlines & depends on your destination). Luggage in excess of these limits will be charged for at the appropriate excess baggage rates. Baggage is the responsibility of the passenger at all times (Travel Insurance is strongly recommended).

Insurance Protection: We strongly recommend you take out a Travel Insurance policy which is available from Gullivers Sport Travel. Policy booklets are available from Gullivers Sport Travel.

Billeting: If billeting is included in your itinerary, every attempt will made to secure billeting as per the itinerary. In the case that billeting cannot be secured additional costs will be incurred for accommodation required.
